

DAY 1, July 25: Depart United States:

DAY 2, July 26: Florence, Italy

DAY 4, July 28: Tuscany | Volterra | Andrea Bocelli Concert

After breakfast, we are off to Volterra and for a tour of a local alabaster factory. We then visit a Tuscan country estate for wine tasting and an early dinner of local delicacies. After, we are off to hear one of the greatest tenors of alltime, Andrea Bocelli, perform in his hometown of Lajatico. After the concert back to our hotel in Florence. (B|D)

DAY 5, July 29: Florence

DAY 6, July 30: Florence | Orvieto | Rome

DAY 9, August 2: Vatican | St Peter's Basilica

After breakfast, we will set out for a guided tour of the Vatican Museums and The Sistine Chapel. The Vatican Museums display works from the immense collection amassed by the Catholic Church and the papacy throughout the cen-

turies, including several of the most renowned Roman sculptures and most important masterpieces of Renaissance art in



the world. After we will tour St Peter's Basilica, the largest church in the world. The afternoon is yours to enjoy on your own before our Farewell Dinner at a local trattoria. (B|D)
