Pilgrimage to Fatima/Lourdes/Barcelona with Msgr Halfpenny

Day 1 & 2 Monday/Tuesday, September 15 & 16 - Detroit > Lisbon We depart USA en route to Lisbon, Portugal with complimentary meals and beverages served aloft. Upon arrival at Lisbon International Airport, we will be greeted by our tour escort and transferred to our hotel. The afternoon is free to explore Lisbon, perhaps a stroll along Avenida da Liberdade? Later we will reconvene for our fabulous Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight at the hotel in Lisbon. (D)

Day 3 Wednesday, September 17 - Lisbon/Santarem/Fatima Today we tour Lisbon with stops at Church of St. Anthony, the Jerónimos Monastery and the Church of Santa Maria, the Tower of Belem, the monument dedicated to Henry the Navigator, the Castelo dos Mouros, and the Praca do Comercio. After lunch on our own, we leave Lisbon and stop in Santarém to visit the Church of the Eucharistic Holy Miracle before arriving in Fátima. After dinner at the hotel, join pilgrims from around the world for the Rosary and candlelight procession at the Our Lady of Fátima Basilica. (B|D)

Day 4 Thursday, September 18 - Fatima Today we will visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary where the tombs of Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta, the three children who were visited by Our Lady of Fatima, are located, Basilica of the Holy Trinity, as well as the Chapel of Apparitions. We will celebrate Holy Mass and visit the Fatima Sanctuary, where Our Lady of Fatima appeared in 1917. Lunch on our own, and the remainder of the afternoon free. Back to our hotel for dinner before the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Fatima. (B|D)

Day 5 Friday, September 19 - Fatima/Braga/Santiago de Compostela Today it's off to Santiago de Compostela with a stop in Braga. We visit the Sanctuary of Bom Jesus do Monte, a UNESCO World Heritage site. After Holy Mass we will have lunch in a local restaurant, and then continue to Santiago de Compostela, one of the most significant pilgrimage destinations since the Middle Ages. Dinner at the hotel. (B|L|D)

Day 6 Saturday, September 20 - Santiago de Compostela Today we will have a beautiful half-day tour of Santiago de Compostela, the termination point of the 9th century pilgrimage route "Camino de Santiago" (Way of St James). Our tour ends at Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela and the Tomb of St James. We will celebrate the Pilgrims Mass with the remainder of the day and evening at leisure. (B)

Day 7 Sunday, September 21 - León/Burgos After breakfast, we depart Santiago de Compostela and travel east to Burgos with a stop in León for lunch on our own. We will see the Cathedral of León, one of the most important Gothic structures in Spain, and the Basílica de San Isidoro, a Romanesque church dedicated to Saint Isidore of Se-

ville. Upon arrival in Burgos we will visit its extraordinary Cathedral, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture and burial place of Spain's national hero, El Cid. Dinner and overnight in Burgos. (B|L|D)

Day 8 Monday, September 22 - Loyola/Lourdes Today we depart for Lourdes with a visit to the Sanctuary of Loyola, built in honor of St. Ignatius of Loyola, founder of the Jesuit religious order. We will also visit and have time to pray at the Saint Ignatius' Chapel. After lunch on our own, we cross into France and arrive in Lourdes. After dinner at the hotel, you're invited to join the nightly Rosary and candlelight procession. (B|D)

Day 9 Tuesday, September 23 - Lourdes Today we enjoy a guided walking tour of Lourdes where our guide will share the history of the Marian apparitions that St. Bernadette Soubirous witnessed. We will celebrate Holy Mass and then have lunch at a local restaurant. The rest of the afternoon and evening at your leisure. (B|L)

Day 10 Wednesday, September 24 - Manresa/Montserrat After breakfast we say "Au revoir" to France and return to Spain and the incredible Marian Shrine of Montserrat. On the way, we will visit the town of Manresa where, according to tradition, Saint Ignatius of Loyola secluded himself to pray and do penance during his stay in the city from March 25, 1522 to the beginning of February of 1523 while returning from his pilgrimage to Montserrat. After lunch on our own, we then reach Montserrat, located on top of a monumental massif, and spend the night next to the Monastery. (B|D)

Day 11 Thursday, September 25 - Montserrat/Barcelona This morning we visit the Benedictine Santa Maria de Montserrat Abbey. The monastery was founded in 1025 and now has a community of around 70 monks. The Virgin of Montserrat is Catalonia's patron saint, and is located in the sanctuary of the Mare de Déu de Montserrat. After we celebrate Holy Mass, we leave and drive through the Catalonian countryside for a tapas lunch and wine tasting at one of the Penedes region celebrated vineyards. Upon arrival in Barcelona we will check-in at the hotel with the remainder of the afternoon free. (B|L)

Day 12 Friday, September 26 - Barcelona Today we enjoy a guided tour of Barcelona including a drive around Montjuïc to see the Olympic Stadium and a great panoramic view city. Continue to the city where we will visit Gaudi's Batlló and then his masterpiece—La Sagrada Família. We celebrate Holy Mass, and the rest of the day is yours. This evening, we will celebrate our pilgrimage a Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant. (B|D)

Day 13 Saturday, September 27 - Barcelona > Detroit Today we fly home after our incredible spiritual journey through Portugal, France and Spain. Thank you Msgr Pat and God bless! B
